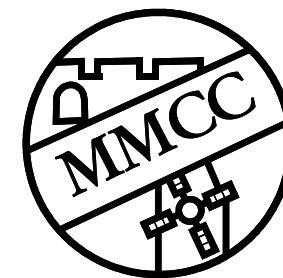

To enrich our students' education still further, the PTA is asking those who are able to consider making a donation to the college through the PTA. As a charity, the PTA is able to take advantage of substantial tax benefits on donations made by tax payers.

Can you support our College?

Any gifts, no matter how small, by cheque or cash, will all help to enhance the educational experience of students at the college, helping them to realise their potential, whatever their abilities.

You can choose between making a one-off donation or spreading your support over the year by filling out the Standing Order Mandate attached, thereby keeping control of your payments. Please return the form, along with the Gift Aid Declaration, to the college in a sealed envelope marked for the attention of the PTA Treasurer.

What is Gift Aid?

Gift Aid is the simplest, most effective way of having the Inland Revenue give back the tax that has already been deducted from your earnings, 'topping up' your initial donation to the college.

How does it work?

For every £1 you donate to the college, the college can reclaim the tax already paid on that £1. If you or your spouse pays the higher tax on earnings, the difference between the higher rate and the rate we claim back can be reclaimed by yourselves.

For example:

You give	College Receives	if 40% tax payer
£78	£100	£60
£156	£200	£120
£234	£300	£180

A regular gift made:

Monthly	Over four years	if 40% tax payer
£6.50	£400	£240
£13.00	£800	£480
£19.50	£1000	£720
